for any number of performers
for one or two cycles

Assemble a group of performers at a nearby laundromat and have each participant choose a dryer of their own. Each performer should bring enough change for one or two dryer cycles (these days 15 minutes is typical), plus one additional coin. This additional coin is the only object allowed to be placed in each person's dryer, and performers should neither be tempted to put more than one coin in their dryer, nor to use more than one dryer per person. On cue, all dryers with coins should be started simultaneously. Performers should be silent and attentive before, during, and between cycles, and should be respectful of other customers.
